STUDENT SERVICE HOUR REQUIREMENTS For Practical Christian Ministry

PURPOSE

A corporate conviction of Quad Cities Christian School is that young people need to receive the stimulation and the training in Community Service in order to:

- a. gain insight into the needs of others
- b. see how one person can make a difference
- c. become involved in the local church and Christian community

(Matthew 28: 19-20; Acts 1:8)

It is our desire to help our students gain a Christian World View, to be motivated to experience a closer walk with God, and to bring glory to Him through their ministry. The Practical Christian Ministry requirements provide this opportunity.

REQUIREMENTS

Each student must meet **the minimum** hours of Missions/Service requirement **each quarter** the student is enrolled at QCCS. These hours do not carry over to another quarter. Hours earned during the summer may be applied to 1st Quarter.

- a. 6th- 8th grade students must perform 6 hours of service per quarter.
- b. 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students must perform 8 hours of service per quarter.
- c. **Community Service requirements must be met in order for a student to be promoted or graduate.**

Taking a class field trip or going on a retreat does not qualify for hours.

Active participation means “doing” not listening, watching, or observing.

You must be supervised directly or indirectly by an adult.

Service must be selected from Ministries list or pre-approved by the School Administration.

Recording the hours will be done after the student turns in the “Missions/Service Requirement Form” signed by the adult supervisor.
